 - Faithfulness is determined by God, not by how others judge us – 1 Cor. 4:1-5; 5:3-5; Matt. 18:15ff.
 - Paul didn't trust his own judgment Acts 26:9
- The only infallible standard is God's word Heb. 4:12

- We will obtain a crown of life 2 Tim. 4:7-8
- Examination is needed to resist Satan desire to dislodge us from the faith!

 - Doctrine 1 Tim. 4:1; Eph. 4:4-5; 2 Tim. 2:15

- We must determine the strength of our faith by the tests it has faced in the fires of life.
 - What kind of person are you at work, school, etc.? Mt. 10:32-33
 - Do you seek to do good for others? Phil. 2:3-4
 - Do worldly things regularly take precedence over worship to God, Bible classes, and other spiritual activities? – Matt. 6:31-33
 - Do you endure affliction, disappointment, etc., with faith in Christ and without complaining or bitterness? – Phil. 2:14-16

 - Whether you are abiding in the doctrine of Christ
