The Problem

- Christianity and churches are being molded to fit the current needs/desires of our culture
 - Traditional Christianity is said to be irrelevant
 - We are seeing the product of the no-pattern doctrine of the past 100+ years
- Why is this a problem?
 - When you change Christ's revealed pattern and build what people want, it stops being Christ's church
 - Christ said he would build HIS church Matt. 16:18; 2 Tim. 3:14-15; Eph.
 3:10-11

- God is the God of glory Rev. 4:6-11; 5:9-14
- His glory is rightfully due Him Psa. 29:1-2
 - His power is glorious Col. 1:10-11
 - His holiness is glorious Ex. 15:11
 - His works are glorious Psa. 111:2-4

If we understand things as we should...

- We understand creation to be for God's glory Psa. 19:1-3
- We understand God's labors are for His glory Acts 17:26-27; Heb. 11:6
- We understand man's redemption is for God's glory Eph. 1:11-12; 1 Pet. 2:9; Matt. 5:16
- We understand a faithful life is for God's glory Phil. 1:9-11; 1 Cor. 6:18-20; 1 Pet. 4:10-11, 14; 1 Cor. 10:31

Conclusion
