# Truth 3: Characteristics of Truth

## Truth is Objectively Determined

- **■** Our feelings, thoughts, or beliefs do not determine the truth.
  - Many are championing the idea that truth is simply what you want it to be.
  - Truth cannot be determined that way—it exists outside our thoughts/feelings
  - Ex: Scientific truth exists outside of our feelings—gravity
- **■** Biblical truth exists as truth, no matter what I may think/feel about it.
  - God's word is truth Jn. 17:17
  - Bible truth exists outside of us...in the Bible
  - We may not like it, want to reject it or change it, but it is still the truth!
  - God's truth can only be known by reading and accepting the Bible's words

#### Truth Can Be Offensive

- # This is what has turned our world away from God's truth.
- **♯** Spiritual truth can be offensive
  - Disciples were offended at Jesus' teaching about being the food leading to eternal life Jn. 6:53ff.
  - The Pharisees were offended at Jesus' doctrine because it contradicted theirs Matt. 15:11-14
- ■ People continue to be offended at the teaching of Christ for the same reasons today

## Truth is Not Determined by Who Believes it

- # That certain people or powers hold to something doesn't make it true.
  - Catholic Church enforced as divine truth that the earth was the center of the universe
  - The Catholic Church was wrong!
- **■** Bible truth is not determined by who believes it.
  - The spiritual leaders of the Jews rejected Jesus Jn. 7:45-49
  - The wise and influential of this world reject Jesus -1 Cor. 1:25-31
- ₩ We cannot base our faith on *who* believes what 2 Pet. 2:1-2; 2 Tim. 4:1-2; Acts 17:11

### Truth is Not Determined by How Many Believe it

- **■** When Christopher Columbus set sail, most believed the world was flat.
- **■** Spiritual truth is not determined by how many believe it
  - $\blacksquare$  Only eight souls were saved by believing the truth in Noah's day -2 Pet. 2:5
  - Jesus said most people will reject the truth Matt. 7:13-14
- **■** Just because the religious majority might...
  - Reject baptism doesn't mean it isn't essential Acts 22:16; 1 Pet. 3:21
  - Accept instrumental music doesn't mean it is acceptable Eph. 5:19
  - Use recreation and social activities to draw the world doesn't mean this is what Christ desires Mark 16:15-16; 1 Cor. 1:21-24; 2:1-2; 2 Cor. 10:3-5
- **■** We must stay within the revealed truth Rev. 22:18-19
