Is Spiritual Growth!

- Greater spirituality amplifies our sin...which can be frustrating! Rom. 6:1-2, 5-6
- Sin is a reality Rom. 3:23
 - Only God is good Matt. 19:17
 - Our righteousness is filthy rags Isa. 64:6
 - ∘ To see ourselves otherwise is deception − 1 Jn. 1:8

Is Lost

- Like the Jews of old, *time* can blind us to our faults Rom. 2:1
- These blind spots set us up for temptation and sin − 1 Cor. 10:12
- Being blind to our faults is like Tom Whittaker forgetting his handicaps!

Is Necessary to Reach our Goal
