Why a Collection on Sunday?

The Sunday Collection

- We have O.T. precedence in the tithe commanded for the support God's work – Heb. 7:1-3; Lev. 27:30, 32; Num. 18:23-24
- We have similar N.T. instructions:
 - When a need arose, Christians contributed to a church treasury to meet that need – Acts 4:34-35
 - Paul commanded the churches to collect money to support the Lord's work Gal. 2:9-10; 1 Cor. 16:1-2

What We Learn from 1 Cor. 16:1-2

- When a scriptural need arose, churches were commanded to meet that need
- Churches were commanded to act on "every first day of the week" to meet this need
- Individual members were to set aside funds to be stored up, or placed in a treasury
- Christians were to determine the amount to give by how God had prospered them, or carried them on life's journey.
- This money was placed in a church treasury
- NOTE: Although this collection was for benevolence, local churches were commanded to support the preaching and teaching of the gospel 1 Cor. 9:11, 13-14; Phil. 4:15-16; 2 Cor. 11:8

How Can Churches Support God's Work Today?

- We know it is right to collect money by freewill giving
- We know it is right to collect this money on Sunday.
- We know it is right to store, or treasure up this money for future use.
- We know it is right for collected funds to be used for various scriptural purposes.
- Conclusion: A general church treasury is scriptural today and we must support it properly.

Questions Answered

Proper Attitude?

- The O.T. tithe is helpful:
 - Holding back in one's tithing was to rob God Mal. 3:8
 - Honesty was required—Deut. 26:12-13
 - Although the O.T. tithe is no longer, Christians have it much better in every way than did Israel! More is expected!
- N.T. requirements:
 - Our giving must be motivated by Christ's gift of Himself 2 Cor. 8:8-9
 - A willing mind to give according to what one has 2 Cor. 8:12
 - Cheerfulness in giving bountifully 2 Cor. 9:6-7

How Much Should I Give?

- God's kingdom must take priority Matt. 6:31-33
- The amount is dependent on one's income and situation.
 - If you are living a blessed lifestyle, your generosity must reflect this.
 - Good rule of thumb: 1) Multiply your Sunday contribution by 10; 2) Ask God to provide you a weekly income of that amount!
- Extraordinary circumstances require extraordinary sacrifice Acts 4:33-35
