## We Considered...

$\diamond$ The O.T. shadow of the sacrificial system with its blood sacrifices given in the Passover and the offerings for sin.
$\diamond$ The staggering numbers of innocent animals that had to die as part of this shadow.
$\diamond$ How these sacrifices, being only a shadow, were powerless to take away sin! - Heb. 10:1-4
$\diamond$ How Jesus is the wonderful fulfillment of the sacrificial system, being God's Lamb and bringing true forgiveness - John 1:29

## Jesus Our Passover Lamb

$\diamond$ Jesus, our Passover lamb, has been sacrifice for us - 1 Cor. 5:7
$\diamond$ Israel had to purge their houses of leaven before the Passover and feast
$\diamond$ Each household sacrificed their unblemished lamb by their own hand, put its blood around the door, and remained in their house until morning.

## $\diamond$ Fulfilled in Christ and the church

$\diamond$ Christ is our spiritually unblemished sacrificial lamb offered to redeem us from the bondage of $\sin -1$ Pet. 1:18-19
$\diamond$ Christ suffered by Israel's own lawless hands - Acts 2:22-24
$\diamond$ Christ's blood applied to our lives "delivers us from the wrath to come" - 1 Thess. 1:10
$\diamond$ We must remain in Christ and His church/house to be saved from wrath Acts 20:28; 1 Tim. 3:15; Heb. 3:12-14
$\diamond$ The Lord's Supper is the memorial of our redemption

## Jesus Our Sin Offering

$\diamond$ Jesus was offered to bear the sins of the world
$\diamond$ In conjunction with and in contrast to the Day of Atonement, Jesus offered Himself once for all time to bear the sins of all - Heb. 9:21-28; Isa. 53:11
$\diamond$ He is the first and only all-sufficient sacrifice for sins!
$\diamond$ Jesus suffered "outside the gate" - Heb. 13:10-12
$\diamond$ Jesus fulfilled the O.T. sin offering that was burned outside the city.
$\diamond$ As this O.T. rite signified the separation of the people from sin, so Christ's suffering brought true separation from sin
$\diamond$ Jesus accomplished what the blood of sacrificial animals could noteternal redemption for all - Heb. 9:11-15
