GRACE DEFINED

- That which gives joy, pleasure, delight; loveliness – Eph. 4:29; Col. 4:6
- Goodwill, loving kindness, favor of God on the undeserving Eph. 1:7; 2:8; Titus 2:11

WHY WE NEED GRACE

- Because our sin will condemn us at the Judgement – 2 Cor. 5:10; Rom. 3:23; 6:23; Rev. 21:8
- Because as sinners we are unable to save ourselves
 - Saving ourselves requires perfect obedience Gal. 3:10; Rom.
 3:23; 6:23
 - A sinner can never do enough good to negate his/her sin and its condemnation – Rom. 3:20; 7:9-11

WHAT DOES SALVATION BY GOD' GRACE MEAN?

- We can be saved apart from perfect obedience to God's law – Rom. 3:21-24
 - This does not mean obedience is unnecessary Heb. 5:8-9; 2 Thess. 1:7-8
 - It does mean that we do not have to earn salvation by perfect obedience to God's law
- A tremendous price for our redemption had to be paid
 - The wages of sin is still death! Rom. 6:23
 - For God's righteousness and justice to remain intact, the price of God's own blood had to be paid! – Rom. 3:24-26; Tit. 3:3-7
