Facing the Storms

Matthew 8:18, 23-27

"Now when Jesus saw a crowd around Him, He gave orders to depart to the other side of the sea... ²³ When He got into the boat, His disciples followed Him. ²⁴ And behold, there arose a great storm on the sea, so that the boat was being covered with the waves; but Jesus Himself was asleep. ²⁵ And they came to Him and woke Him, saying, "Save us, Lord; we are perishing!" ²⁶ He said to them, "Why are you afraid, you men of little faith?" Then He got up and rebuked the winds and the sea, and it became perfectly calm. ²⁷ The men were amazed, and said, "What kind of a man is this, that even the winds and the sea obey Him?"

"Leaving the crowd, they took Him along with them in the boat, just as He was; and other boats were with Him. ³⁷ And there arose a fierce gale of wind, and the waves were breaking over the boat so much that the boat was already filling up. 38 Jesus Himself was in the stern, asleep on the cushion; and they woke Him and said to Him, "Teacher, do You not care that we are perishing?" 39 And He got up and rebuked the wind and said to the sea, "Hush, be still." And the wind died down and it became perfectly calm. 40 And He said to them, "Why are you afraid? Do you still have no faith?" 41 They became very much afraid and said to one another, "Who then is this, that even the wind and the sea obey Him?"

Mark 4:35-41

Luke 8:22-24

"Now on one of those days Jesus and His disciples got into a boat, and He said to them, "Let us go over to the other side of the lake." So they launched out. 23 But as they were sailing along He fell asleep; and a fierce gale of wind descended on the lake, and they began to be swamped and to be in danger. 24 They came to Jesus and woke Him up, saying, "Master, Master, we are perishing!" And He got up and rebuked the wind and the surging waves, and they stopped, and it became calm. ²⁵ And He said to them, "Where is your faith?" They were fearful and amazed, saying to one another, "Who then is this, that He commands even the winds and the water, and they obey Him?"



Those who Travel with Jesus will Face Storms

- This trip was by Jesus' command Mt. 8:18
- The disciples followed Jesus Mt. 8:23; Lk.
 6:46; Mt. 10:24-26, 28
- Because they followed, they encountered the storm
 - They were in danger and the knew it! Lk. 8:23-24
 - We will face the storms as well

Jesus was Sleeping

- Despite the wind, tossing, and waves,
 Jesus slept Mt. 8:24; Jn. 16:33
- Jesus' sleep caused them to question his caring Mk. 4:38; Eph. 1:18-19
- Jesus then rebuked their fear and lack of faith! Mt. 8:25-26
 - He rebuked them before He calmed the storm.
 - Why Jesus rebuked them was not because they knew he could do miracles and fix this – Mt. 16:5-12; Rom. 8:31ff.
 - Why rebuke them now? Because they assumed their peril meant He did not care.



Jesus Calms the Storm

- After the danger and the rebuke, Jesus calmed the storm – Mt. 8:25-26
 - Confident faith is not about Him calming all life's storms
 - We trust that Jesus to calm the storms after this life is over
 Rev. 14:13
- The result of Jesus' salvation is the disciples' fear and amazement Lk. 8:25
 - This does not end with cheering and hugs!
 - They feared because they were in the presence of God –
 Psa. 89:8-9
 - Fear is important because it leads us to fully trust God Ex. 14:30-31; 2 Tim. 4:18
