Luke 11:27-28; 5:1-11



## The Events – Luke 5:1-11

As the eager crowd pressed against Him, Jesus entered Peter's boat and asked him to move it off the shore - 5:1-3

After Jesus finished teaching, He commanded Peter to go to deeper water and cast out his nets, for which Peter was rewarded - 5:4-7

When the men saw the miracle and understood its meaning, they reacted in proper fashion - 5:8-11; Isa. 6:5: Acts 2:36, 38



## Application

Obedience to the Lord in small matters is essential to receiving greater blessings - 5:1-3; Mk. 9:41

Faith expressed in obedience produces blessings - 5:4-7; Lk. 6:46-49

Obedience to Christ always benefits others - 5:3, 6-11; Jn. 6:63; 5:24; Mt. 25:34-40; 2 Cor. 2:14-16; 1 Pet. 3:1-2

Those who obey Jesus will not be disappointed - 5:6-7; Heb. 5:8-9; Jn. 10:8-10
