

## **Deliverance From Sin**

Problem – God knows our sin and need for deliverance – Rom. 3:23; Jas. 1:14-15

Power – God sacrificed His Son to address the problem – Rom. 5:6-8; 1:15-16

Precept – God commands us to take the gospel to the world – Mt. 16:15-16; Mt. 28:18-20; 2 Cor. 6:18-19

Promise – God will be with us – Mt. 28:20

#### **Church Discipline**

<u>Problem</u> – God knows when there is sin among His people – 1 Cor. 5:1-2; 2 Thess. 3:11

<u>Power</u> – God provides the solution – 2 Thess. 3:6

<u>Precept</u> – God gives instructions for addressing the problem – 2 Thess. 3:11-12, 6; 1 Cor. 5:5, 11

<u>Promise</u> – God's power/authority provides strength to succeed – 1 Cor. 5:3-5 Problem – God knows our struggles, challenges, and fears – Gen. 3; Acts 14:21-22

### Struggles of Life

Power – God chose to live and die in human flesh to address our problems – Heb. 2:14-15; 4:14-16

Precept – God exhorts us not to fear or worry – Mt. 10:28-31; Lk. 12:27-32; 1 Jn. 4:18-19

Promise – God's love, peace, and victory in Christ are assured – Rom. 8:35-39; Jn. 16:33; Rev. 2:9-10
