 - Gender the fact or condition of being a male or a female human being
 - Gender specific of or limited to either males or females
- Webster's Dictionary for Students (2003)
 - Gender sex

- Gender sex (as in) the feminine gender
- Gender the behavioral, cultural, or psychological traits typically associated with one's sex
- Gender identity a person's internal sense of being male, female, some combination of male and female, or neither male nor female

The Current Confusion

- Society wants to erase the boundaries of gender
- Men, women, and children are encouraged to cross the boundaries of gender
- It is claimed that gender is fluid, flexible
- Society says that mixing or rejecting gender will result in harmony. But that is wrong.
- The unexpected consequences for women

God, Creation, Gender, and Genesis

- God formed then filled creation, with the climax being the creation of humanity - Gen. 1:26-28
- As males and females, we are all made in God's image. This means:
 - God did not begin with our differences, but equality Acts 17:27-29
 - We are different from animals
 - We gain our identity from God
 - We have a purpose
 - We have a function Gen. 1:28

God, Creation, Gender and Genesis

- Genesis 2 gives specifics of our creation
- Man was created first and put in the garden to work and keep it, but was alone - Gen. 2:15, 18-20
- Woman was created to be a helper suitable for the man - Gen. 2:15, 21-22
- Man and woman (male and female):
 - Are to be joined together in marriage
 - Must work together to fulfill their God-given function of subduing and filling the earth
 - Need a redeemer which would come through the woman - Gen. 3:15

Why the Confusion?

- Satan and sin
 - Pushing rejection of anything connected to God
 - Sinful views of men toward women
- The fall of mankind Gen. 3
 - Adam and Eve disobeyed God bring a curse
 - **Men** who are to work the land face challenges of weeds and much toil 3:17-19
 - **Women** have multiplied pain in childbirth and strife with their husbands 3:16; Eph. 5:22-27
 - Gender and relationship problems began with sin, but answered in Jesus - Gal. 3:28
